Some Thoughts About Skill Levels. . .

Every year, one of the comments we see most frequently on our Workshop Feedback Survey concerns wanting classes to move at the skill level at which they are listed. All skill levels are welcome at the Sling, we just ask that you be honest with yourself and with the teachers about your skill level. We use the skill level you provide on the registration form to decide how to allocate classes to best serve the skill levels of the students. Classes will be designated as either "Beginner", "Advanced" or "Open" (Open classes are just that -- open to all, no matter your skill level). To help you decide which section is best for you, please consider the following guidelines.

If you...

- Have no experience
- Have performed fights in a show, but not taken classes
- Have taken a few classes
- Have taken quite a few classes, but not tested
- Have passed the SAFD Actor/Combatant skills test in 3 weapons and then stopped studying or allowed it to lapse
- Have not taken class during the past year
- Think you know all about stage combat
- you are probably a Beginner student.

If you...

- Have studied consistently for at least two years
- Have passed the SAFD Actor/Combatant skills test in more than 3 weapons (or equivalent)
- Have continued your studies after testing
- Have kept your skills & test status current
- Can't believe how much more there is to learn
- you are probably an Advanced student

These are only guidelines, to which there may be exceptions, but for the safety and enjoyment of everyone at the Sling, try to be realistic in your assessment. Everyone wants to partner with someone slightly better than themselves -- an obvious impossibility. If you have questions, consult with a staff member. If we see someone whom we feel would be better off in the other section, we will make changes as needed. Remember, no-one thinks less of a beginner, unless they are slowing down an Advanced class! Also, you're NOT Advanced just because you came to the first two days of the Sling!
